Arizona Community Colleges to Arizona State University

Students who hope to transfer to Arizona State University and pursue a major in the School of Music (pending a successful application and audition) are encouraged to complete the academic and performance courses included in this document. The application process includes applications to both ASU and the School of Music, as well as an audition.

Course numbers shown are for Maricopa Community Colleges, unless otherwise indicated. Students should use **aztransfer.com** to look up the most current equivalencies for transfer from their community college to ASU. A grade of C or better is required for all courses.
