The DMA in Music with a concentration in music composition requires a total of 90 credit hours, a foreign language exam, a written comprehensive exam, an oral comprehensive exam, prospectus and a dissertation are required for the degree program. Students with a completed master's degree from an accredited institution recognized by the ASU Graduate College may be approved for up to 30 blanket hours toward the DMA (depending on master's coursework), leaving 60 credit hours of coursework to complete. Shaded sections of the check sheet represent possible blanket credit hours from a master's degree.

Student Handbook

Degree Requirements and Timeline

There are several milestones and requirements throughout the DMA program in addition to the required coursework listed above. All work towards a doctoral degree must be completed within ten consecutive years from the semester of entry.

Diagnostic Exams	Summer before first semester (June 15)

Two Foreign Language Exams	It is recommended that both languages be completed within the first two years of coursework and no later than the end of the fourth semester.

Graduate Curriculum Breakdown

Every course taken for a doctoral degree must have a graduate course number (500+). You will not receive graduate credit for courses at the 400-level or below. You may take courses at the 400-level or below, but the courses will not count toward your degree. Most students take four years (not including summers) to finish the degree. Here is a sample of a full-time plan.
