Student Handbook

The student handbook should be used in conjunction with this degree check sheet. The current handbook can be found on the student canvas site. Students should also review the ASU Graduate Policies and Procedures handbook.

Degree Requirements and Timeline

All work toward a master's degree must be completed within six consecutive years from the semester of entry.

- Complete the diagnostic exams in music theory and musicology before your first semester.
- Successful completion of the diction and sight-singing diagnostic exam or successful completion of designated courses in diction and
 musicianship (voice performance and opera performance tracks only)
- File a Plan of Study (second semester) via the interactive iPOS system located on your My ASU page. You should also have an approved supervisory committee by the end of your third semester.
- Successfully give one solo recital performance and one other performance as approved by your committee (voice performance track only)
- Successfully perform in two main-stage productions as approved by your committee (music theatre and opera performance tracks only)
- Successfully pass written exam during the final semester of study.
- Apply for Graduation in your final semester of study.

Graduate Coursework

Every course taken for a master's degree must have a graduate course number (500+). You will not receive graduate credit for courses at the 400-level or below. You may take courses at the 400-level or below, but the courses will not count toward your degree. When courses are double listed under both 400-level and 500-level numbers, always take the 500-level section. Courses at the 600- or 700-level are usually for doctoral students and require permission from your faculty advisor and the instructor of the course. You may take 600-level courses, but check first with the instructor or your faculty advisor.
